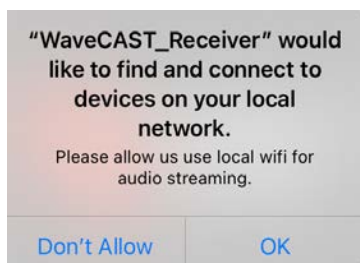


WaveCAST IOS Private Address

With the introduction of IOS 14, Apple has introduced the Private Address feature. More information about this feature is available at <https://support.apple.com/en-us/HT211227>

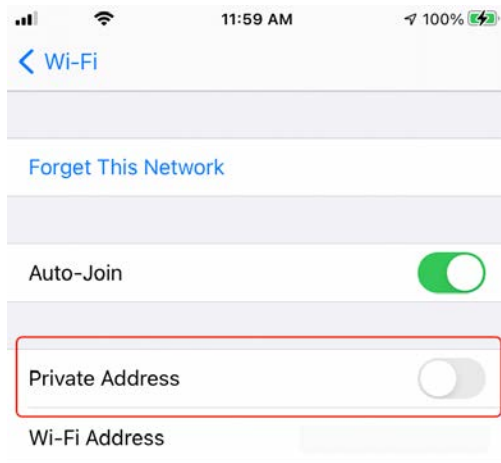
This feature is **not** compatible with the WaveCAST Wi-Fi system and will need to be disabled to use the WaveCAST app on your IOS device.



Local Network Connection Approval:

When opening the WaveCAST App, you may receive a pop-up notification asking if the WaveCAST_Receiver can connect to devices on your local network. This is verifying that is OK for the app to access your network, which is required for your personal device to receive the audio stream. Tap **OK** to approve.

If you have accidentally tapped Don't Allow or did not receive the prompt, you will have to manually enable the feature. In your device settings, navigate to **Privacy->Local Network, and enable the WaveCAST app** to access your local network.



To disable Private Address connections:

1. Open your device settings. (This is outside of the WaveCAST app).
2. Enter Wi-Fi Settings.
3. Tap the information icon for the WaveCAST audio network.
4. Disable the Private Address setting.
